The towering, powerful giraffe is slowly wandering up the spiralling slope with many other fabulous giraffes gracefully following. Its long, reaching neck stands tall upon its strong, wide shoulders which empowers the giraffe to proudly hold its pointed, patterned head up high. Below the giraffe's thick, rounded body, it has bony, lengthy legs which are firmly supported by black, sharp hooves. The giraffe's brown face has two oval eyes either side of its head which helps it to see all around where it is currently standing.
