Working On It

Subject: Food Costs

The dog needs 1 tin of dog food every day.

On special occasions - his birthday and Christmas - he must also be provided with a treat.

Dog food costs €10.00 for 7 tins.

Treats cost €5.00 each.

Subject: Vet Costs

The dog must be taken to the vet for a health check-up once a year.

Each visit costs €20.00 but you have a half price voucher on your first health check.

He must also be given 2 booster vaccination injections to keep him safe from diseases.

Each injection costs €10.

Subject: Kennel Costs

Each summer the dog must spend 2 weeks in kennels while his owners are on holiday.

Each week cost €6.50

Subject: Additional Costs

The dog must have new bowls for food and water every year.

On his birthday and at Christmas he should be given a toy.

Food bowls cost €6.00

Water bowls cost €4.00

Toys cost €2.50

Subject: Food Costs

The dog needs 2 tins of dog food every day.

On special occasions - his birthday and Christmas - he must also be provided with a treat.

Dog food costs €12 for 7 tins.

Treats cost €5.25 each.

Subject: Vet Costs

The dog must be taken to the vet for a health check-up 3 times a year.

Each visit costs €31.00 but you have a half price voucher on your first health check.

He must also be given 2 booster vaccination injections to keep him safe from diseases.

Each injection costs €7.20.

Subject: Kennel Costs

Each summer the dog must spend 3 weeks in kennels while his owners are on holiday.

Each week cost €6.30

Subject: Additional Costs

The dog must have new bowls for food and water twice a year.

On his birthday and at Christmas he should be given a toy.

Food bowls cost €6.20

Water bowls cost €4.30

Toys cost €3.55

Smashed It

Subject: Food Costs

The dog needs 2 tins of dog food everyday.

On special occasions - his birthday and Christmas - he must also be provided with a treat.

Dog food costs €12 for 10 tins.

Treats cost €4.99 each.

Subject: Vet Costs

The dog must be taken to the vet for a health check up every 3 months.

Each visit costs €29.68 but you have a half price voucher on your first health check.

He must also be given 2 booster vaccination injections to keep him safe from diseases.

Each injection costs €11.22

Subject: Kennel Costs

Each summer the dog must spend 3 weeks in kennels while his owners are on holiday.

The first week costs £98 but in the second and third week a 10% discount is available.

Subject: Additional Costs

The dog must have new bowls for food and water 4 times a year.

On his birthday and at Christmas he should be given a toy.

Food bowls cost €6.23

Water bowls cost €4.39

Toys cost €3.59
